“3rd Person Singular of Present Tense”



The 3rd Person Singular of the Present Tense is how we express how either “HE,” “SHE,” “IT,” or “YOU” (formal) are currently doing something, or normally do something.



Verbs are conjugated according to the endings, either -AR, -IR or -ER.

-In order to conjugate an -AR verb, you SUBTRACT the “AR”, and ADD the letter “A.”

-To conjugate an -ER or -IR verb, you SUBTRACT the “ER or IR”, and ADD the letter “E.”

Regular Conjugation of -AR Verbs (HABLAR)

<i>He</i>	él	HABLA	<i>They (masc.)</i>	ellos	
<i>She</i>	ella	COME	<i>They (fem.)</i>	ellas	
<i>You (formal)</i>	Usted	SALE	<i>Y'all (formal)</i>	Ustedes
